Rob Hermans did a great job conducting the racing for our first winter event, and manning the support boat with Andrew Carter's help. So a big vote of thanks to you both for setting a good course and enabling a fun day. We had a good combined fleet of 16 boats - 8 Sabres, 6 Lasers and 2 Mirrors.

The format for winter is to set a windward and leeward mark only, with two laps through a mid course start/finish line, so the races are usually around 30 to 40 minutes each depending on wind strength. The wind gods were kind enough to send a light 5 to 8 knot breeze from the south/south east just before the 1pm start and the combined fleet got away to some good, close racing.

Well done to Pete Coop, visiting Sabre from East Fremantle who won both races on yardstick. It was great to see so many visitors and club members at the first Winter race, good close racing and good fellowship being the real winners on the day.
